# **Coppicewood College Booking Terms and Conditions**

#### Definitions:

Short Course: Any course of four days duration or less

Medium Course: Any course of more than four days but less than 5 months

Long Course: Any course of more than 5 months duration

Participant: Any individual who has secured a place on any of the courses operated by

We/us: Coppicewood College

You: The participant

### **Short Course:**

- These Booking Terms and Conditions form the entire agreement between the participant and Coppicewood College.
- We do not accept a deposit to secure a place on any short course
- Payment in full is required to secure a short course place. Until such time as payment is made no place is secured.
- Cancellations made up to 8 weeks prior to the course commencement date are refundable subject to administration fees.
- Cancellations made less than 8 weeks prior to the commencement date will only be eligible for a refund if we are able to fill the course completely.
- All cancellations must be advised in writing to info@coppicewoodcollege.co.uk
- A cancellation administration fee of 15% of the price of the course will be deducted from any refund to which candidates are entitled
- If you find you are no longer able to attend a course that you have booked we will allow you to transfer the course place to another individual at no additional charge, subject to the following conditions:
  - we are provided with the details of the new course participant at least one week before the course commences
  - the alternative participant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions and meets requirements in place for the relevant course
- If for any reason whatsoever we need to cancel a course that has already been confirmed, we will refund the full cost of the course for any secured place
